- 1 Deodorant 2-3 oz. stick, roll on, or pump
- 1 1-gal Re-sealable Plastic Bag
- Place all items in the re-sealable plastic bag. Add a \$2 Donation for razor and toothpaste.


STUDENT KIT (\$16 VALUE)
